He is an outstanding teacher that has completing revitalized our music and band program. Mr. Alfrey is a 34 year veteran teacher holding a Master's Degree from Ball State University. He is an accomplished Band Director earning several state championships throughout his career in percussion, winds, and winter guard. Mr. Alfrey's previous music programs have earned superior rating in orchestra and marching band. Randolph Southern School Corporation is a small rural school located in Lynn, Indiana. Further, they finished 17th in the overall performance for all schools and missed the top 16 by .75%.

Mr. Alfrey's passion has bled over to the elementary whereby the culture has changed to inspire and encourage kids to participate. He has made it cool to be in band! For the first time, senior band members have their poster up alongside athletes in the high school gymnasium. It has been amazing to watch our students' talent blossom while performing the National Anthem, Sweet Caroline, or Queen. The Christmas program was a sellout and the students treasured the tunes performed. The school corporation purchased 20 guitars for a new class this year. Mr. Alfrey and the students performed 3 songs for the audience with only a semester to practice.
